






Install 2 suitable 10 mm shims in the illustrated position. This will allow the caliper pistons to be extended with out the risk of them being fully removed.



Apply pressure to the bake pedal to allow the caliper pistons to be partially extended.






Remove the 2 10 mm shims.



Using a suitable trim tool or pick, release the caliper dust boot from the caliper assembly.






- Slide the caliper dust boot up the caliper piston to allow the caliper piston to be inspected.
- Clean and inspect the caliper piston, If corrosion is visible a new caliper is required.





Remove the caliper dust boot from the caliper piston.



Install the caliper dust boot onto the piston caliper. Make sure the caliper dust boot is located correctly onto the piston.



Carefully push the caliper dust boot and the caliper piston partially into the caliper bore. Make sure that there is no damage to the piston surfaces during this installation.

NOTE:

Make sure the caliper dust seal is corrected fitted.



Fully install the caliper dust boot into the caliper bore. Inspect the caliper dust boot to make sure that it is fitted correctly.

4. Install the brake caliper.
