DISCOVERY 3 (ALL MODELS ARDUOUS) MAINTENANCE CHECK SHEET

Adjust/Lubricate/Replace - Labour cost included in scheduled time except items marked * Check - After the checking procedure, cleaning, adjusting, repairing or replacing is subject to extra labour and material cost.

- Oil OIL SERVICE
1. Renew engine oil and filter (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)
2. Inspect brake pads for wear, calipers for leaks and disks for condition (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)
3. Inspect road wheel speed sensor harness for damage (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)
4. Drain fuel sedimentor (Diesel) (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)
5. Adjust the electric park brake shoes (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)
6. Check the condition of the electric park brake system (Every 3 months / 3,750 miles)

- MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE INTERIOR)
7. Check condition and security of seats and seatbelts
8. Check operation of all lamps, horns and warning indicators
9. Check operation of front/rear wipers and washers and condition of wiper blades
10. Select the LOW range gears and drive the vehicle 3 to 4 vehicle lengths then re select HIGH range gears
11. Replace pollen filter

- MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE EXTERIOR)
12. Annual corrosion/cosmetic inspection - Using annual corrosion inspection sheet
13. Check tyre pressures, condition and tread depth.
14. Remove road wheels
15. Replace Brake Fluid (Every 2 years)*
16. Renew fuel filter element (Diesel)
17. Refit road wheels to opposite sides of the same axle (Use anti-sieze compound on spigot bore) Not vehicles fitted with uni-directional tyres
18. Visually check intercooler/radiator for external obstructions and fan blades for damage
19. Renew the air suspension inlet filter (75k)
20. Check operation of door checks, bonnet catch & fuel flap and lubricate door checks
21. Apply lubricant to door seals - Russian and Nordic markets only

- MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)
22. Check anti-freeze specific gravity
23. Renew coolant (Every 10 years)*
24. Renew spark plugs (Vehicles using leaded fuel or low cost spark plugs)
25. Renew spark plugs (45k)
26. Renew air cleaner element (Petrol)
27. Renew air cleaner element (Diesel)
28. Clean throttle disc (V8 - Gulf markets only)
29. Check condition of ancillary driving belts
30. Renew ancillary driving belts (Petrol) (75k)
31. Renew ancillary driving belt (Diesel) (45k)
32. Renew front and rear camshaft timing belts, tensioners and tensioner bolt (Diesel) (60k)

- MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)
33. Check/top up brake, PAS and clutch fluid levels and screen washer reservoirs
34. Check exterior of intercooler and remove debris using low pressure hose.
35. Check/top up battery electrolyte level. - low maintenance battery fitted
36. Check battery condition and check/top up battery electrolyte level. - low maintenance battery fitted - MENA markets only

- MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)
37. Renew engine oil and filter
38. Renew manual gearbox oil (Every 10 years) (150k)
39. Renew automatic transmission oil and filter (Every 10 years) (150k)
40. Renew transfer box oil, replace drain and fill plug washers (75k)
41. Renew front and rear axle oil (Every 10 years)
42. Renew locking differential oil (75k)
43. Check for free play in all suspension and body mounting rubbers
44. Check condition of all suspension, driveshafts and steering boots and gaiters
45. Replace all flexible brake hoses (Every 6 years)*
46. Check visually brake servo hose, brake, fuel, PAS and clutch pipes, unions and electrical harnesses for chafing, leaks and corrosion
47. Check for fluid leaks
48. Check exhaust system for leaks, security and damage
49. Check steering rod ball joint fixings and condition of ball joints and dust covers
50. Check torque of tie rod end nuts. - M12 tie rod end nuts only - 76 Nm
51. Check shock absorbers/height sensors and harness assembly for leakage and damage
52. If fault lamp(s) are illuminated, interrogate that system using T4/IDS and report findings*
53. Carry out road test (see WARNING over page)
54. Reset service interval announcement indicator
55. Endorse service record
56. Check for any applicable outstanding service actions or recalls
57. Report any unusual features of vehicle condition and additional work required

The maintenance items listed, are those recommended for vehicles operating under arduous driving, road and climatic conditions. More frequent attention may be necessary if the vehicle is subject to stop/start operation, extremes of temperature, dusty conditions, off road driving or frequent towing of trailers. See recommendations on back of sheet. Service check completed, cosmetic/corrosion inspection check completed and service portfolio book endorsed.
