ULEZ Enquiry

Thank you for your recent correspondence on the 12 February 2021, regarding Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) scheme.

The ULEZ Scheme requires vehicles to meet the following standards;

- Petrol Vehicles must be Euro 4 or have NOx emissions equal to, or less than, 0.08 grams per kilometre.
- Diesel Vehicles must be Euro 6 or have NOx emissions equal to, or less than, 0.08 grams per kilometre and Particulate Matter emissions equal to, or less than, 0.005 grams per kilometre.

Please note:

- Euro 4 became mandatory for all new cars in 2005 and light vans in 2006
- Euro 6 became mandatory for all new heavy duty engines for goods vehicles and buses from January 2014, September 2015 for cars and light vans, and September 2016 for larger vans up to 3.5 tonnes.

The ULEZ charge is determined by the vehicle category recorded on the vehicle's V5c document (section 'J' Vehicle Category). The charges are detailed as follows:

- £100 per charging day in respect of a DVLA Class M3, Class N2 and Class N3.
- £12.50 per charging day in respect of DVLA Class L, Class M1, Class M2 and Class N1 sub-classes (i), (ii) and (iii)

Based on the information you have provided, we can confirm that both VRMs are not compliant and the daily charge for each should be £100.00

We will update these two VRMs on the database accordingly.
